This privacy information informs you how Fa. Unifeeder (see full information below) collects, uses and shares your personal data according to GDPR (General Data Privacy Regulation EU 2016/679 of April, 27 2016) and other laws and local regulation when we ask for your consent to process your information in a certain way.

3. Purpose of processing and categories of personal data	For the recruitment process of Unifeeder, the categories of personal data used are applicant master data (e.g. name, address, communication data), qualifications, job and other references and results of personality tests as collected from you.
4. Legal basis for the processing of personal data	The personal data is used to carry out the recruitment process as well as to possibly sign an employment contract (§ 26 BDSG (German data privacy law) and in particular paragraph 8).
5. Recipients or categories of recipients of personal data	The recipients of personal data are our employees in the local HR department who are responsible for the application process, our relevant employees in HR department of the head quarter and the deputy managing director. Personal data will not be transferred to third parties.
6. Transfer of data to third countries	Personal data will not be transferred outside the European Union.
7. Duration of storage and deletion of personal data	The personal data will be stored for six months as of start of the application process and will be deleted thereafter.

	Any longer period of data storage will require your prior consent.
8. Automated decision making including profiling	Neither automated decision-making nor profiling measures are used.

Additional Information

You have the following rights:

Information about your personal data stored (Art. 15 GDPR): In particular, you may request information about the purposes of the processing, the category of personal data, the categories of recipients to whom your data has been or will be disclosed, the planned duration of storage, the existence of a right to adjustment, deletion, limitation or appeal of processing, the existence of a right of complaint, the origin of your data if it has not been collected by us and on the existence of automated decision-making including profiling and, where appropriate, meaningful information on its details. · Correction: Should incorrect personal data be processed by us (Art. 16 GDPR).

Cancellation and limitation as well as objection to the processing by us (Art. 17, 18 and 21 GDPR).

Right to data transmission (Art. 20 GDPR: That is receiving your personal data which you have provided to us in a structured, common and machine-readable format or requesting transmission to other responsible parties.

Revocation of consent (Art. 7(3) GDPR): As a result, we are not any longer allowed to process data as based on this consent in the future.

Right of appeal to the responsible supervisory authority (Art. 77 GDPR).

Right of revocation of consent

You have the right, within the meaning of Article 6, Paragraph 1, Letter a or Article 9, Paragraph 2, Letter a, to revoke at any time and without disadvantages for himself/herself any consent given for instance for the performance of the contract, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing carried out on the basis of consent until revoked.
